HOUSING

Members of the Futures Steering Group met with Mayo County Council Housing Department officials recently to get an update on the proposed Social Housing project in the village. It was confirmed that the planning process is now complete and work will commence in March/April 2023 with an expected completion within 52 to 72 weeks.

There will be a total of 16 houses built - 8 two bedroomed and 8 three bedroomed - and all the houses will be built to a very high specification and will be very energy efficient.

This is a very positive development for the viability of our village and community and, in particular, our School. If you and your family are eligible (or if you know of a family or a person who may be eligible) to be on the Social Housing List we would encourage you to grasp this opportunity and apply to Mayo County Council as soon as possible.
